This page is to serve as your official introduction to the Tiwa Archaeological Society of the University of New Mexico. Tiwa is an organization of undergraduate students who are either prospective majors or minors under the Department of Anthropology. It was founded in March of 1935. Aside from making occasional disturbing rackets in the Department's wing of the Administration building, it offers members valuable extra-curricular contacts with the science of anthropology. The field work of the society has consisted of survey work in the Santa Fe Sub-Quadrangle A, surface collecting from several ruins in the Albuquerque area, and the excavation of two caves in the Sandia Mountains. The Davis cave was completely cleared in the spring of 1936, but work is still going on in the Sandia cave. It is hoped that the latter will produce further evidence of Pleistocene man in America. Open meetings of the society, with guest speakers, are held every Wednesday at Five o'clock in the Departmental lecture hall. The society holds closed business meetings on Fridays at the same time.
